INDUCTION PROGRAM



Poona Institute of Management Sciences and Entrepreneurship organized a 9-day orientation program in collaboration with Barclays for first-year MBA students. 



 - 6. Ethical considerations






16. Expert Guidance Talk on Effective Preparation for Competitive Examinations-
